

# Bay State College Graduation Performance Summary

The federal government's Student Right-to-Know (SRK) legislation requires that all colleges and universities report the percentage of college students who began their studies full time and who completed their programs within 150 percent of the length of the program.

There are many factors that may impact timing of graduation. Most Bay State College students are working while attending to their studies. Students may start out as a full-time day student and then switch divisions or programs within the college. Student may also choose to take a semester off to manage other responsibilities. All of this can be factored into the Graduation Results below.
