Dual Enrollment Program FAQs***

Who is eligible to take part in a BSC Dual Enrollment Program?

Bay State College's Dual Enrollment Program is open to all juniors and seniors attending an accredited high school, or home school.

Where are classes held?

Students enrolled in Bay State College's Dual Enrollment Program will have the opportunity to attend classes on campus or online. In some cases, a class may be available at the students' high school.

Can I enroll in more than one class at a time?

Students are limited to one class per term. Any additional classes will be at the discretion of the advisor.

Will my Bay State College credits count towards my High School requirements?

This will be at the discretion of the participants' high school.

Can I transfer the credits to another college?

Students wishing to transfer their Bay State College credits to another institution are advised to inquire with the receiving school to determine their specific transfer credit policy.

Will I attend class with other Bay State College students?

High school students will be joining Bay State College students in their classes, both online and on-ground. In the case of a class held on a high school campus, only students from that school will attend the class.

Why should I take a Dual Enrollment class at Bay State College?

Bay State College offers small class sizes, taught by industry professionals who have experience in both industry and academia. Bay State College student-to-faculty ratio is 13-1, allowing for a supportive atmosphere, designed to allow students to develop confidence in their ability to complete college-level coursework.
